

CROSSROADS SHAWL



The Crossroads shawl is textured for an eye catching design. Make it in cake yarn, create your own stripes, or solid colors.

Finished Sizes: approx. 63” wide x 28” tall (at center); after blocking.

Yarn: #4 worsted weight yarn (10 oz. total)

Sample used Caron Cakes *Pistachio Fudge*, 2 cakes (650 yds)

Crochet Hook: Size K/10.5 (6.50 mm) hook

Notions: Yarn Needle

Gauge: 7 x-sts = 4½" (before blocking)

Special Stitches:

- **Magic Ring** – See my tutorial – [How to Make a Magic Ring](#). If you’re struggling with the magic ring, see my post [Alternative to the Magic Ring](#).
- **cross stitch (x-st):** skip next st, dc in next st, working in front of dc just made, dc in skipped st (cross st made)

Abbreviations

ch – chain

x-st – cross stitch

dc – double crochet

hk – hook

sc – single crochet

sl st – slip stitch

yo – yarn over

Shawl

Begin with Magic Ring (see Special Stitches), ch 3 (counts as dc).

Row 1: Working in magic ring 2 dc, ch 1, 3 dc, turn. (6 dc, 1 ch-1 sp)

Row 2: (WS) Ch 1, 2 sc in 1st dc, sc in each dc across to ch-1 sp, 3 sc in ch-1 sp, sc in each dc across to last dc (which will be the tch), 2 sc in tch, turn. (11 sc)

Row 3: (RS) Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same st as ch 3, *x-st (see Special Stitches) across to center sc, (dc, ch 1, dc) in sc, x-st across to last sc, 2 dc in last sc, turn. (6 dc, 4 cross sts, 1 ch-1 sp)

Row 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in 1st dc, sc in each dc across to ch-1 sp, (sc, ch 2, sc) in ch-1 sp, sc in each dc across to last dc (which will be the tch), 2 sc in tch, turn. (18 sc)

Row 5: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same st as ch 3, *x-st across to center sc, (dc, ch 1, dc) in center sc, x-st across to last sc, 2 dc in last sc, turn. (6 dc, 8 cross sts, 1 ch-1 sp)

Row 6 – 51: Rep Rows 4 – 5, ending with row 5.
Fasten off.
